The University of Chicago is committed to the development of a sustainable transportation system where transit, walking and bicycling are the primary modes of travel. The Bicycle Master Plan analyzes existing conditions, recommends bicycle facilities, gives best practice examples of facilities and programs at peer institutions, and recommends education, encouragement and enforcement strategies to create a bicycle friendly university. The greater intent of this Plan is to institutionalize bicycling as part of the UChicago transportation system while improving existing bicycle facilities, adding new facilities where needed, and providing more educational opportunities to the campus community that help improve safety for all modes of travel even as the number of bicyclists increases. Ginkgo provided planning assistance to Toole Design Group for the overall framework and developed the 3D visualizations for major plan recommendations.
